


THADDEUS BLACK--Son of Claudette Smith Black and James received a Certificate of recognition for participation in the Bolivar County Jubilee Spelling Bee.


TRAVIS R. SMITH--Son of Claude and Rosa received a Masters Degree in  Education

Mildred is now employed in a Math Program in Philadelphia, PA.

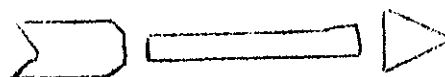
CONGRATULATIONS COUSIN MILDRED!

KENNETH LLOYD SMITH--Son of LLOYD & ERNESTINE married SHIRLEY CHATMAN.

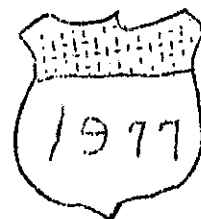
KENNETH RAYON--Son of COUSIN LOIS and the late PAUL married MARSHALL SINGLETON.

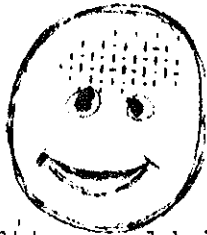

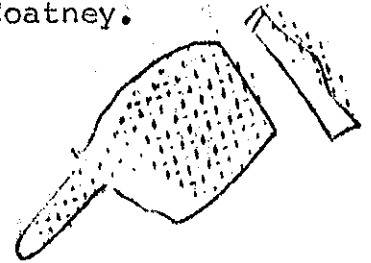
